## SHELTER & SLEEP ESSENTIALS

### What to Look For

- Lightweight 1-2 person tent under 4 lbs for easy packing.
- Inflatable pad or foam mat that insulates from cold ground.
- 3-season sleeping bag (30-40°F) that compresses well.
- Camp pillow or stuff sack used as a dual-purpose pillow.
- Foldable groundsheet for clean setup space.

## BASIC COOKING GEAR

### Efficient & Minimal

- Pocket stove with iso-butane fuel for simplicity.
- Titanium or nesting cook kit with spork.
- Waterproof matches or firestarter tool.
- Collapsible bowl for meals and sponge for cleanup.
- Sample food pack: dry grains, soup, or snacks.

### Extra Value for New Campers

- 10 ft paracord for repairs, tie-downs, or food hang.
- Silicone pouches or compression sacks to save space.
- Rechargeable headlamp or clip-on tent light.
