CABLE ORGANIZATION TOOLS

Tidy Up Loose Wires

- Cable clips to anchor cords along desk edges or shelves.
- Cable sleeves to hide multiple wires behind monitors or under desks.
- Cable boxes to contain power strips and reduce visual mess.
- Under-desk trays or adhesive mounts to suspend cables neatly.

DESK POWER OPTIONS

Stay Powered and Ready

- Clamp-on power strips with USB-A/C for desk-edge access.
- Surge-protected power stations to safeguard all devices.
- Desk grommet outlets for seamless plug-in access near monitors.
- Smart hubs with USB-C charging for laptop and phone docks.

SETUP & LABELING TIPS

Simplify Access and Adjustments

- Label power vs. data cables before routing.
- Pre-measure cable lengths based on workspace layout.
- Use Velcro ties for easy re-routing and bundle changes later.
