## MULTI-USE SAFETY TOOLS

### Gear That Handles More Than One Emergency

- Compact multi-tool with knife, pliers, scissors, wrench.
- LED headlamp with tilting mount and backup batteries.
- Rechargeable flashlight with solar panel or hand crank.
- Foldable mylar blanket that doubles as shade or ground sheet.

## ROADSIDE & CAMPSITE ALERTS

### Stay Visible, Heard & Prepared

- Reflective vest or triangle for breakdowns or night setup.
- Fire starter, waterproof matches, or butane lighter.
- Whistle and glow stick combo (great for signaling or night hikes).
- Compact emergency radio (NOAA or hand-crank option).

## VANLIFE REPAIR & CONTAINMENT GEAR

### Fix, Fasten, and Improvise on the Go

- Duct tape and zip ties for temporary roadside fixes.
- Work gloves, rags, and folding shovel or scraper.
- Mini tire inflator or patch kit if no full spare available.
- Ratcheting straps or bungee cords for mobile repairs.

## SMART PACKING & LABELING

### Make Your Kit Easy to Use Under Stress

- Pack all items in a weatherproof grab pouch or case.
- Label tools and medical items using waterproof markers.
- Store kit near driver-side exit or rear hatch panel.
- Print a contact card with emergency info and ICE numbers.
