Hardware Alternatives to Stream Decks

- Macro Pads: Compact 6-12 key boards for triggering stream scenes or commands.
- Programmable Keyboards: Use secondary layers for media, macros, or transitions.
- Rotary Dials: Add control for volume, zoom, or scene timing with precision.
- Touchscreen Apps: Run Deckboard or Touch Portal on a spare phone or tablet.

SOFTWARE & COMPATIBILITY

What to Look for in App & Device Support

- Check for OBS, Twitch, or YouTube Studio compatibility.
- Look for scripting or plug-in support (e.g. Touch Portal plugins).
- No-driver or plug-and-play options simplify setup across systems.
- Ensure devices support profile switching between apps.

ERGONOMIC DESIGN & PERFORMANCE

Features That Boost Efficiency

- Angled or magnetic bases improve placement and comfort.
- Cross-platform support ensures flexibility (Windows/macOS/Linux).
- RGB keys help in dim lighting during content creation.
- Tactile feedback improves speed during high-pressure streams.
