VIDEO PERFORMANCE

What to Look For

- 1080p resolution for sharp video - full HD is minimum for pro appearance.
- 30fps minimum frame rate; 60fps if available on a budget.
- Built-in low-light correction is a bonus in poorly lit spaces.

MICROPHONE FEATURES

Built-In vs. Expandable

- Dual built-in mics are helpful if you don't have external audio.
- Noise reduction mics help clean up voice for calls or streams.
- Check for 3.5mm or USB mic support for later upgrades.

SETUP & HARDWARE

Mounts + Privacy

- Flexible mount: clip-on and tripod compatible.
- USB plug-and-play requires no extra software.
- Built-in privacy shutter gives peace of mind when idle.

Extra Tips for Value Shoppers

- Ring lights can improve clarity - even for webcams with low-light support.
- Choose webcams with autofocus or adjustable angles.
- A webcam under \$50 can still deliver pro-level results with proper lighting.
