WHAT TO LOOK FOR

Know Your Budget Mic Types

- USB Condenser Mics: Plug-and-play with solid clarity for streaming, podcasting, and calls
- Dynamic Mics: Better for noisy rooms; more focused pickup
- Lavalier Clip-Ons: Great for mobile tutorials or hands-free talking head videos
- Mini Boom Mics: Lightweight, directional options for isolated recording on cameras or tripods

BEST VALUE

Top Features to Prioritize

- Cardioid pickup pattern for voice focus
- Sturdy tripod stand or boom arm included
- Built-in gain control or mute button
- USB-C or USB-A compatibility for laptops + tablets
- Optional headphone monitoring jack (rare but useful)

HELPFUL ADD-ONS

Low-Cost Extras That Improve Quality Fast

- Foam windscreen or pop filter to reduce harsh p-sounds
- Simple soundproofing panels for echo control
- Dual-purpose USB hubs or splitters for easier setup
- Budget audio interface (if upgrading to XLR later)
