Quick Buying Guide for Game-Ready Grip, Fit & Entry-Level Value

FIT & COMFORT FIRST

Play-Ready From Day One

- Lightweight synthetic uppers with flexible break-in
- Padded heel collar to reduce blister risk
- Breathable mesh tongue or vents for cooling
- Medium-wide shape best for beginners learning movement

TRACTION & FIELD TYPE

Match the Surface, Maximize Grip

- FG (Firm Ground): For outdoor grass fields
- TF (Turf): Short rubber studs for artificial turf
- IC (Indoor Court): Flat rubber soles for futsal and gym floors
- Avoid using FG cleats on turf - can cause joint strain

BEGINNER-FRIENDLY EXTRAS

Small Add-Ons, Big Convenience

- Extra insoles or arch inserts (optional for comfort)
- Shoe bag to separate cleats from gear or clothes
- Stud brush or pick for cleaning grip zones post-play
