

How to Stay Fresh Off-Grid - Build a Compact Hygiene & Sanitation Kit

Post-Purchase Setup Guide for Hygiene in the Wild, on the Road, or Without Full Facilities

WATERLESS WASH STATIONS

Set Up a Safe, Smart Handwashing Station

- Use a squeeze bottle or soft bladder mounted to a tree or van door
- Secure soap leaves or liquid inside a small zip pouch nearby
- Place a drip tray or drying mat below to avoid runoff near your campsite

TOOTH CARE WITHOUT A SINK

Master a Quick, Minimal Dental Routine

- Brush using solid toothpaste tabs and a collapsible toothbrush
- Spit greywater into a sealed waste pouch or dig-away hole (away from water sources)
- Use 30mL or less per brush session with rinse cup technique

OVERNIGHT CLEANUP FLOW

Prep for Sleep in Dusty or Humid Environments

- Use a final body wipe-down with airflow to dry quickly
- Apply lip balm, nose balm, and foot powder for night comfort
- Keep a 'next to pillow' pouch with your sleep hygiene tools

HYGIENE IN TIGHT SPACES

Stay Fresh While Living Inside a Van or Tent

- Designate clean/dirty zones using packing cubes or dividers
- Line one crate with a washable liner for daily used items
- Rotate gear placement by time of day (morning kit vs. night kit)

LEAVE-NO-TRACE PRACTICES

Dispose Responsibly Without Damaging the Environment

- Pack out used wipes in sealable bags labeled by date
- Use a collapsible trowel for greywater and rinse runoff away from camps
- Never bury synthetics, pack out all non-organics no matter how small
